There are several state parks that could use your hands and time!

Please note: In accordance with the provisions of <u>DHRM Policy 4.40</u>, employees seeking to use School Assistance and Volunteer Service Leave for these opportunities will need to coordinate their volunteer time through the **Virginia Association for Parks (VAFP)**, a non-profit organization dedicated to supporting the efforts of Virginia's national, state, and regional parks. To do so, volunteering employees should provide notice to each volunteer site that their hours are being worked through VAFP. In return, the volunteer site will provide a certified letter attesting to the volunteer hours worked.
