

New ODGA and DMV Data Owner Trainings

The Virginia Office of Data Governance and Analytics (ODGA) has created two new role-based data governance trainings in partnership with the Department of Motor Vehicles for Commonwealth of Virginia Employees- the <u>Data Governance for Data Owners</u> and <u>Data Governance for Data Custodians</u>. These trainings are required for certain Commonwealth employees under <u>Virginia Code Section 527</u>. The Data Owner Training is for agency heads or other data owners in the Commonwealth and covers topics such as data owner responsibilities, data professional roles, how to best share data, and more. The Data Custodian training is for Data Custodians in the Commonwealth and aims to educate about Data Governance roles in the Commonwealth and Data Custodian responsibilities.
